She studied in Economics and Development Department at European Commission. After working as a general coordinator in NYC from 1993 to 1999, she earned graduate degrees in Applied Psychology and Educational Sciences in Peace Education from Bogazici University. She made studies at Harvard University on Multiple Intelligence at the Project Zero. In 2013, she was awarded her PhD in Educational Sciences from Bogazici University, and she wrote her thesis on the Transformation of the Higher Education through Techno-parks, using Turkey and Silicon Valley as case studies. Since July 2013, she has worked at the Technology Transfer Office of Istanbul University as the Director of the Intellectual Property Rights and Licensing to empower creativity, innovation, and entrepreneurship, including intellectual property rights of the students and researchers from different industries.
